The children will be celebrating the completion of our pre-kindergarten program. **ALL Pre-kindergarten** children will go through the program even if they will be returning to our school next year. # Important Reminders

- It is dangerous for children to run out the gate by themselves, especially with the parking lot and Euclid Ave. being just a few steps away. <u>Please be sure to hold</u> on to your child's hand as you exit.
- Never leave children alone in a vehicle under any circumstances.
- Please remember to sign up for snack and bring it on your designated day. The children love sharing the snack their parents sign up to bring.
- Make sure that the snacks you bring are in their original containers. We always need to be able to check for allergens and expiration dates. Thank you so much!

Like a butterfly, time has flown. You have learned and you have grown. Tiny chairs give way to desks, Book reports and spelling tests.


So take off now, spread your wings, Soar to new heights, learn new things. Just remember, as you do, Someone's VERY, VERY proud of you!!!
