



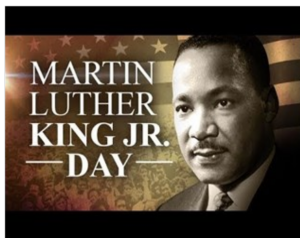

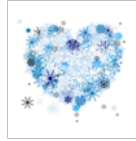

## *Illness Policy*



It is our top priority to keep our students, families and staff healthy and safe, especially during this time of year.

Please watch your child for symptoms of illness and ***DO NOT*** send him/her to school if you suspect he/she may be coming down with something, or your family has been exposed to someone else who is sick.

⇒ No child who arrives to Preschool noticeably ill, with a rash or with a fever, will be admitted for that day. Should a child become ill during the day, the parent will be notified for ***immediate pickup.***

For the protection of your child, as well as others, please keep your child home if he/she has any of the following symptoms:

⇒ **runny nose, coughing, vomiting, nausea, headache, earache, ear discharge, abdominal pain, diarrhea, sore throat, skin rash, inflamed eyes, enlarged glands, or fever.**
