Dear Parents,

Our school has always made the safety of the children a top priority. Our staff are certified in Pediatric CPR and First Aid. Another way we address our children's safety has been with Earthquake Preparation. Our school has accessible storage of water, tools, portable shelters, portable toilets, first aid equipment, and many other emergency equipment items that help us to feel prepared in the event of a major earthquake. These items have been purchased over the years through preschool fundraisers and they are stored for our children's use.

Each year we ask that the families assist us with our earthquake preparedness by providing items to be used only in the case of an earthquake. These items are food items that need to be replenished with fresh items each year. (Please check the expiration date on your donation to make sure it will be good through our school year, May 2023.) We are asking each family to contribute to our earthquake kits with a specific donation.

Requested Earthquake and Consumable items Per Classroom

Mrs. Assal: Individual Fruit Cups- in a package of 4 or more AND 3 pack facial Tissue (any brand)

Mrs. Nessel: 3 Cans of Individual Servings of Spaghetti O's AND 200 count (5 oz paper cups Dixie)

Mrs. Merrill: 1 box Pop Tarts AND 3 pack Clorox Disinfectant Wipes

Mrs. Corral: 1 box of Graham Crackers AND 3 Pack Disinfectant wipes

Mrs. Knight: 1 Case of Bottled Water AND 3 Pack of Facial Tissue

Mrs. Meganne: 3 Cans of Individual Servings of Spaghetti O's AND 200 count (5 oz paper cups Dixie)

Mrs. Struempf: 4 Individual Tuna lunch kits AND 200 count (5 oz paper cups Dixie)

Mrs. Robertson: 4 Bottles (5.5 oz) of 100 % Apple Juice AND 2 Pack baby wipes (100 count) any brand
